**THE CELESTIAL PHARMACOPEIA** Austin Coppock - 10:15 AM – 11:15 AM

A brief investigation of the astrological *materia medica* reveals that there is no one planet of healing. In fact, every planet has its own unique medicine and associated therapeutic techniques. To fiery Mars belongs the intemperate heat of the sauna and the sweat lodge, while Saturn holds the key to the tremendous benefits of fasting. Astrology was used for diagnosis, prescription and treatment and in timing nearly everything in the healing process. Super medicines were created by harvesting and administering herbs at precise times according to the Moon. Why was so much lost? 
